It is our pleasure to offer an on-site compliance vaccination clinic, at Madison Middle School. Clinics will be offered at school during school hours on **Friday March 26, 2021**. Health Heroes vaccination clinics are completely voluntary and are offered to ALL consented students, regardless of their insurance coverage.

**Who is Health Heroes, Inc.?**

At Health Heroes, we specialize in on-site vaccination clinics. Vaccines are provided at **NO OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSE** to students. We bill both Medicaid and private insurance; however, **we never bill students or parents for any out-of-pocket expenses or deductibles**. Qualifying uninsured students can be given the vaccine, free of charge. Although student participation is voluntary, these vaccinations are recommended to help keep schools healthy and cut down on high absenteeism.

**What type vaccines will be given?**

Tdap- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis: upcoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders

MCV- Meningococcal ACWY: upcoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders

**What do you need to do to participate?**

If you wish for your child to participate, please COMPLETELY fill out and sign a consent form. These forms need to be returned to your child's school by **Tuesday, March 23, 2021** to secure a dose for your child. You **must** fill out all the insurance information. If no insurance, please mark correct box.

Please check with your child's physician if you are not sure that these vaccines are needed, prior to signing them up.
