Before 7th grade, students are REQUIRED for school attendance by the State of Ohio to have the Tdap and Meningococcal vaccine. Ohio law allows medical, religious, and philosophical exemptions. **Proof of vaccination or exemption must be turned in before picking up their 7th-grade schedule next year.** Vaccines can be obtained at the Health Dept, your physician's office, or some pharmacies.
