In order to track the behavior trends of your child, please download the Bloomz app! This app will also be used by both your child's teacher as well as the school to communicate with you on a regular basis. Please make sure to download the free app and use your child's classroom code to gain access to important information; you can even check your child's progress to his or her behavior goal each day!

## Choose your weather!

In order to adhere to the guidelines established under the Ohio Department of Education's Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS), students have the opportunity to earn points, not lose them, each day. The following analogies will often be used to increase student understanding:

4 points: Sunny

3 points: Partly Cloudy

2 points: Cloudy

1 point: Rainy

0 points: Stormy

\*In a 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> grade rotation, students can earn a maximum of three (3) points in each class rotation, so a three-point award is considered "sunny".

## Leadership Celebrations

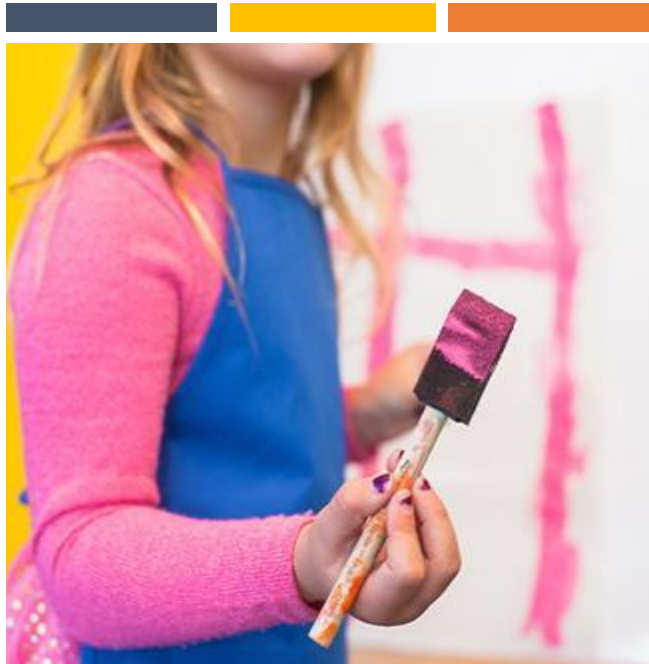

## Students in K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade:

Students in these grade levels will earn points throughout three different parts of the day to earn a maximum of ten (10) daily points. Points are awarded as follows:

Morning: 0, 1, 2, 3 or 4 points  
Afternoon: 0, 1, 2, 3 or 4 points  
Special: 0, 1, or 2 points

## Students in 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Grade:

Students in these grade levels will earn points throughout four different parts of the day to earn a maximum of ten (10) daily points due to students switching classes for different subjects. Points are awarded as follows:

Rotation One: 0, 1, 2, or 3 points  
Rotation Two: 0, 1, 2, or 3 points  
Rotation Three: 0, 1, 2, or 3 points  
Special: 0 or 1 point
