NURSE'S NOTES

Hypothermia & Frost Bite

As the weather gets colder it is important to remember these tips.

- Dress in layers, warm inner clothes, coat, snow pants, hats and gloves.
- Get plenty of food & fluids to fuel your body to stay warm.
- Signs of frost bite include red & cold skin, prickling & numbness, tingling, & stinging.
- Signs of hypothermia include feeling cold, shivering, & the "Umbles:" stumbles, bumbles, grumbles, and mumbles.

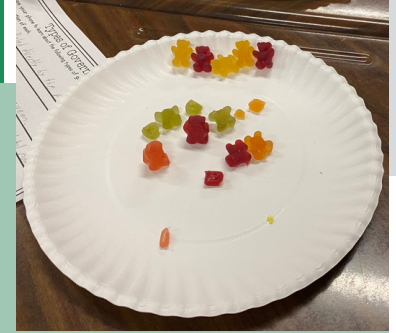
