• FINAL FORMS-IMPORTANT!

Reminder that Madison Local Schools is now using Final Forms to simplify the back-to-school process for our families while reducing paper usage. All school forms should be completed online electronically. Parents and students must log back on using their login from last school year to re-sign their forms for the coming school year and add any updates (address changes, phone number, health information, emergency contact information). If your address has changed since last school year you will need to provide proof of residency to our office. Reminder that 7<sup>th</sup> grade students have to provide proof of TDAP and Meningococcal shot in Final Forms. <u>To lessen the time it takes to pick up your schedule you will want to complete everything on your Final Forms account before arriving at the building. There will be a limited number of computer devices available to complete the online forms in your Final Forms account.</u>

• Attendance:

The school day is from 7:55am to 2:35pm. Students who arrive after 7:55am will be considered tardy. If your child is going to be absent from school, please call the office by 9:00am to report their absence. If the student is seen by a doctor, please send a doctor's note with the student on the day your child returns to school.

• Arrival/Dismissal (attached map): Student pickup and drop-off (cars) is at the front of the building only. Bus traffic is routed through the back of the building. See attached map for times and procedures. \*Please note that a security sign is needed in the window of a car picking up a child as listed on the attached map.

• Cafeteria:

This school year breakfast for students is \$1.75, and lunch will cost \$3.00. If you wish to put funds on your student's account to purchase additional food from the cafeteria, you can do so by going to the Food Service website under "Departments" and click on "PaySchoolFees". If you need to complete a Free and Reduced Lunch Form to declare financial status and apply for free or reduced prices, you can do so on your Final Forms account or your PaySchools account.

• Cell Phones and any other Personal Communication Devices:

As per board policy students in grades (k-8) are not permitted to use PCDs between classes, at lunch, during recess or other nonacademic times during the school day. Students who attend the Middle School must keep their phones off and stored in their lockers during the day.

• Chromebooks:

All students will receive a school issued Chromebook the first week of school and will need to bring their Chromebook with them to class throughout the day. Students will be responsible for making sure that their Chromebook is charged for their classes. If needed, students will be allowed to charge their Chromebook during homeroom. Additionally, students are allowed to bring their Chromebook home as needed for school use and homework assignments. Students may also store their Chromebook at school in their locker at the end of the school day. Parents and students will need to complete the Chromebook student/parent agreement form in Final Forms before they are allowed to receive their Chromebook.

• Main Office:

The main office for the entire building grades 5-8 can <u>only</u> be accessed through the front building entrance off of Grace Street to ensure the security of the building; not the rear entrance. The office is currently available to answer phone calls and questions Monday through Friday from 7am to 3pm.

## • Student Warm Weather Dress:

Please keep in mind the following board adopted guidelines for student dress:

- -Tops must extend, minimally, to below the waistline and above the shoulders
- -Skirts or shorts may only be worn if they extend, minimally, to the student's fingertips when their arms are fully extended at their side or come to the mid-thigh.
- -Torn, cut, or frayed bottoms may be worn if they are found at mid-thigh length or finger-tip length when the student's arms are fully extended.
- -Sleeveless shirts are not allowed unless a short sleeve or long sleeve shirt is worn underneath
- -Refer to the student handbook on our website for the complete list of dress and grooming expectations

• Transportation:

Parents and relatives who are dropping off or picking up students must do so at the <u>front entrance of the building via Grace Street</u> (see attached map).



\*PICKING UP/DROPPING OFF STUDENTS IN THE LIBRARY PARKING LOT IS NOT PERMITTED.\*

SECURITY (Sign For Your Car) - In an effort to ensure student safety, cars picking up students must have a green security sign with that student's name on it placed on the dashboard of the car you drive to pick up your child(ren). Anyone picking up your child(ren) must have one of these security signs in their window. These signs can be picked up from our office.

curb and sidewalk. Students can only exit the vehicle when the car pulls up into the "Drop/Pickup Zone" where staff members will be standing. For the safety of our students, students should not exit their vehicle prior to pulling up to the "Drop/Pickup Zone". Adults must remain in their car. enter the campus and pull all the way up into the "Drop/Pickup Zone" marked on the map. Students will exit their vehicle on the right side and walk onto the MORNING ARRIVAL; begins at 7:15am (Car Drop off) — Use the marked entrance on the map. Cars will form one lane in the curb lane along the sidewalk as they

loaded, a staff member will signal for them to pull away and exit the campus. The next set of cars that pull into the "Drop/Pickup Zone" will then be loaded. and pull all the way up into the "Drop/Pickup Zone". Staff will be loading all cars in the "Drop/Pickup Zone". Once the cars in the "Drop/Pickup Zone" are END OF SCHOOL DISMISSAL; begins at 2:35pm (Car Pickup) — Use the marked entrance on the map. Cars will form two lanes of traffic as they enter the campus Adults must remain in their car.
