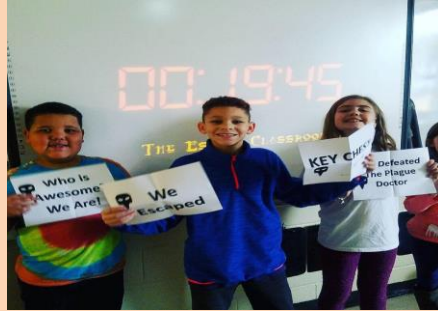

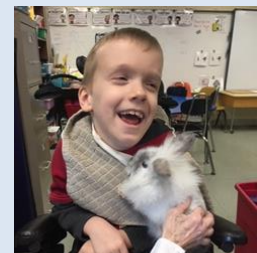

NURSE'S NOOK

Spring is around the corner and so are seasonal allergies! If your child suffers from seasonal allergies/asthma and takes medication at home to relieve symptoms, PLEASE give allergy medication, to include eye drops, EACH day prior to school. Allergy and Asthma Action Plans are important to review and update with your health care provider, and a copy should be on file at school, as well as a rescue inhaler and medications available in the clinic if necessary.
