*Center required paperwork

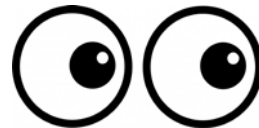
Tuition for typically developing peers is \$100 a month due on the 10th of each month.

Special Service Preschool

Special Services

Students will go through a multi-step screening process to determine if there is a disability.

All students are screened to determine success in fine motor, gross motor, pre-academics and speech and language communication. The result of this screening determines if more standardized testing is necessary. If more testing is necessary a Play-based Assessment (PBA) is scheduled on the first Fridays of the month during the academic school year.

PBA is scheduled with Intervention Specialists, Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist and Speech and Language Pathologists. Results of this assessment will be given in Evaluation Team Review (ETR) meeting within 4-6 weeks of the PBA.

ETR reports will determine the appropriate education service in the Least Restrictive Environment (LRE).

If special services are determined an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) will be written to help each student gain the appropriate skills needed at their current developmental age.

- A one-time per school year \$10 registration fee is needed before placement.
- For children identified as needing services there are no monthly tuition fees.

The paperwork required by the Ohio Department of Education will need to be on file before starting class.

. Which includes:

- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- Immunizations Up to Date
- Custody Paper on file (if this applies to your family)
- Proof of Residency (copy of a utility bill)
- Other center required paperwork to be filled out too.
- *Dental Appointment within 30 days.
- *Physical Appointment within 30 days
